Dear Parents and Carers,

<u>World Book Day</u> - World Book day is on Thursday. A reminder that we are not dressing up this year. The children have all brought home their paper plate to link to a book. Here are the ones created by the teachers. We have a book token for each year group as a prize.

Mother's Day Service - On Friday afternoon, we will be going to church for our Mother's Day Service and we'd love you to join us. If you are able to be there, your child will be able to sit with you for the service. At the end of the service we will be letting the children leave church with you, rather than coming back to school. If you are not able to be at the service, the children will sit with the staff and will return with them to school. They can be collected from school at the



normal time. We are looking forward to celebrating those who care for us. The service will start at 2pm. Create Club will still take place and children attending this club can come back to school with the staff.

Spellings we use the Read, Write Inc. Spelling programme to teach children from year 2 upwards to support the children in developing the key skills of reading and spelling. Read Write Inc. Spelling embeds impressive skills in 20 minute sessions each day, quickly and effectively filling the gaps in children's knowledge. To keep children engaged, aliens introduce spelling rules on an exciting online spelling planet and children complete quick-fire activities in their practice books. They record words linked to the spelling pattern in their log books each week and we ask for your help at home to practice these spellings with them in preparation for their weekly practice tests. The aim is to see the correct spellings embedded in their writing. The way we teach spelling is especially helpful for children who might be dyslexic. This is because we use a very well-organised programme that has a strong focus on phonics. This is very important for children who find learning to spell difficult. If you are worried about your child, please do talk about this at parents evening. The practice at home is an integral part of this process and without it children will struggle to remember the spelling patterns and apply them to their writing. Please speak to Mrs Dommett or your child's teacher if you would be interested in us running a parent information session for the spelling programme.

<u>Parents evenings</u> - Our Parents evening sessions this term take place on Wednesday 13th March from 4pm until 6.20pm and Wednesday 20th March from 3.30pm until 5.40pm. Mr Rogers will be here for the 13th March session and Mrs Martin for 20th March. There will be sign up sheets at the class doors from Monday. Please sign up for a ten minute slot. We value this time to talk about your child with you but in order to help us run to time, if you and the teacher feel more time is needed for discussion at the end of the ten minutes, they will ask you to make an appointment for another time.
