Dear Parents and Carers,

Parents Evening thank you to those parents who came to the first of our parents' evenings this week. It's really important to us as a school that we are working together to support your children. In order that we don't keep other families waiting too long, we might ask you to make another appointment to continue a conversation if you have reached the end of your slot and everything hasn't been covered fully. Don't forget that we are happy to discuss your child at other times - not just parents' evening. If you have any worries or concerns at other times, please speak to your child's class teacher and arrange a convenient time for you both to talk. We are looking forward to next week for our second parents' evening. If you haven't booked a slot yet - please do contact your child's teacher or the office to see if there are any slots available.

<u>Head lice</u> We have another reported case of head lice in school. Don't forget that if you have treated your child before and miss just one egg, it will mean that you haven't eradicated the problem and you need to be alert and continue to check and potentially treat your child's head for the next few weeks. It is always a good idea to check your child's hair weekly as a preventative measure. Having hair tied up will also help prevent the spread. Do read the information leaflet sent with the blue letter.

<u>Walking Home -</u> There is a growing number of children in Owl Class who are starting to walk home by themselves. It's great to see their growing independence. If you are happy for your child to walk home alone, please make sure that you have let us know either by speaking to the class teacher or emailing the office. If you have already told us, you don't need to let us know again.

Starting School September 2024. If you have a child born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020, they are eligible to start school in September 2024. Parents need to apply for their child's school place using the online system at www.westsussex.gov.uk/admissions. Applications must be submitted by the national closing date of Monday 15 January 2024 to be considered as on time. The online system opened on Monday 2 October 2023 at 9.00 am. We have two open days on Tuesday 14th November and Thursday 23rd November. To book to look round the school on one of these days, please contact the office.
